# **Entering MSMS and Class Assignments**

### **Bell Schedule**

Since we are such a large school and we want to create optimal spacing, we have two bell schedules again this year: Early Schedule Division Schedule and Late Schedule Division Schedule. The beginning and end times of day are the same for all students.

Students will be entering our school through one of six different entrances. Doors will be closed at 8:45am daily. If your child arrives after this point, they will enter through the main front doors and check-in with our office staff.
